Hokyou Lee (Yonsei University, Republic of Korea)

Dr. Hokyou Lee is an Associate Professor of Preventive Medicine at Yonsei University College of Medicine and Associate Director of Big Data Platform Division at the Institute for Innovation in Digital Healthcare, Yonsei University, Seoul, Korea. He received his BS in Chemistry from the University of California at Berkeley, and his MD and PhD in Epidemiology from Yonsei University. He was a resident and chief resident of Internal Medicine with a subspecialty in Endocrinology, and a Preventive Medicine fellow and physician-scientist with a subspecialty in Cardiovascular Prevention at Yonsei University Severance Hospital. Dr. Lee served in many cardiovascular societies with leadership roles such as vice chair of the Korean Society of Hypertension Epidemiology Working Group and the Korean Society of Lipid and Atherosclerosis Task Force on Cardiovascular Risk Prediction. His research domain lies in clinical epidemiology and preventive cardiology, with particular interests in life course cardiovascular health, risk prediction, and the epidemiology and outcomes of hypertension, diabetes, and cardiovascular-kidney-metabolic syndromes. He has participated in governmentfunded cohort studies and national cardiovascular disease statistics projects of the Korea Disease Control and Prevention Agency, and in advisory committee for the National Health Insurance Service with expertise in study designs, real-world health data, and clinical implementation.
