Dr. Khalid Al Waili studied medicine in Oman and obtained his Medical Degree in 2001. He then did his residency training in Medical Biochemistry for 5 years at McGill University, Canada, 2004 - 2009. Then he spent two years in Canada, working as a clinical fellow and Scientist in clinical Lipidology at the Royal Victoria Hospital, McGill University, under the direct supervision of Prof. Jacques Genest. The National Lipid Association in the United States also awarded him a certificate in Clinical Lipidology in 2010.

Dr. Al Waili is a Senior Consultant Medical Biochemist and Lipidologist and he is currently the Head of Department of Biochemistry and the Lipid Unit at the Sultan Qaboos University Hospital (SQUH) in Oman. He is a founding member, and currently the vice president of Oman Society for Lipid & Atherosclerosis (OSLA).

His main interest in research is in the field of Lipid and lipoprotein metabolic disorders; Familial hypercholesterolemia and familial hypertriglyceridemia management and genetic cascade screening. He has several publications and one chapter book in the field of lipid and atherosclerosis.
