Won Kim (Seoul National University, Republic of Korea)

Won Kim is working for Seoul National University College of Medicine as the Associate Professor of Internal Medicine. Currently, he is the Editor-in-Chief of Clinical and Molecular Hepatology (2023 JCR IF 14). He is a leading clinical and translational researcher in the field of hepatology and has made significant contributions to the academic community, as evidenced by his publication history. He has authored/co-authored more than 250 SCIE peer-reviewed articles, with 10,439 citations and an h-index of 50. His research primarily focuses on the integrated multi-omics approach for achieving precision medicine in MASLD. He remains active in the academic community through taking on leading roles in various professional societies such as a director of the research committee of the Korean Liver Cancer Association (KLCA), a director of the academic committee of the Korean SLD Study Group (KSSG), and a director of the research committee and the publication committee of the Korean Association for the Study of the Liver (KASL). He is also the president of the Korean Alcohol-related Problems Study Group. In addition, he has served as an associate editor of Gut and Liver. He also leads a talented team of researchers at the innovative target exploration of NAFLD (ITEN) consortium. The ITEN consortium mainly focuses on the development of novel noninvasive diagnostic biomarkers and therapeutic targets against high-risk MASH and advanced fibrosis.
