Sung Nim Han is the professor at the department of Food and Nutrition at Seoul National University. She received PhD degree in Human Nutrition from Tufts University, Boston, USA, in 1999 and completed dietetic internship at Brigham and Women's University, Boston, USA, in 2000. She continued her research in the field of nutritional immunology as Scientist and Assistant Professor at JM USDA Human Nutrition Research Center on Aging at Tufts University until she moved to Seoul National University in 2007. Professor Han served as the president of the Korean Society of Clinical Nutrition (2021) and the president of the Korean Nutrition Society (2023). Professor Han has authored >100 original and review papers and >25 book chapters. Her research areas include alteration of vitamin and mineral metabolisms in chronic diseases such as obesity and diabetes, regulation of immune and inflammatory responses by vitamins and dietary lipids, changes in immunometabolism associated with chronic diseases, and impact of genetic information disclosure on dietary intake and health related behaviors. She served as the associate editor of Journal of Nutritional Science and Vitaminology and currently serving as the editorial board member of IUBMB Life and BioFactors.
